RESEARCH PROJECT WITH GENERATION RENT

Southwark Private Renters Support Project have teamed up with Generation Rent on a research project to understand more about the state of the PRS in Southwark.

The research aims to engage with marginalised communities, to ensure their views feed into work surrounding the Renters Reform Bill, as well as future campaigning. This is an opportunity to expand Generation Rent's research into the experiences of marginalised private renters, allowing them to place greater pressure on the government to address inequality and discrimination issues within the Bill and elsewhere.

Southwark Private Renters Support Project are requesting your support by completing the survey. This work could be key in shaping future changes to the private rented sector in Southwark and nationally.

SOUTHWARK PRIVATE RENTERS CONFERENCE 2024

MORE CHILDREN IN DAMP RENTAL HOMES, FIGURES SHOW

20TH JULY 2024 - BBC NEWS The proportion of private renters with children who are living in damp homes has almost doubled since the pandemic, BBC analysis suggests. The figure has risen from one in 14 households before the pandemic to one in seven in 2022-23, according to the English Housing Survey. One charity said it had been "deluged" with reports of poor housing since the pandemic, with many private renters too afraid of eviction to complain. <u>Read the Full Article Here.</u>
